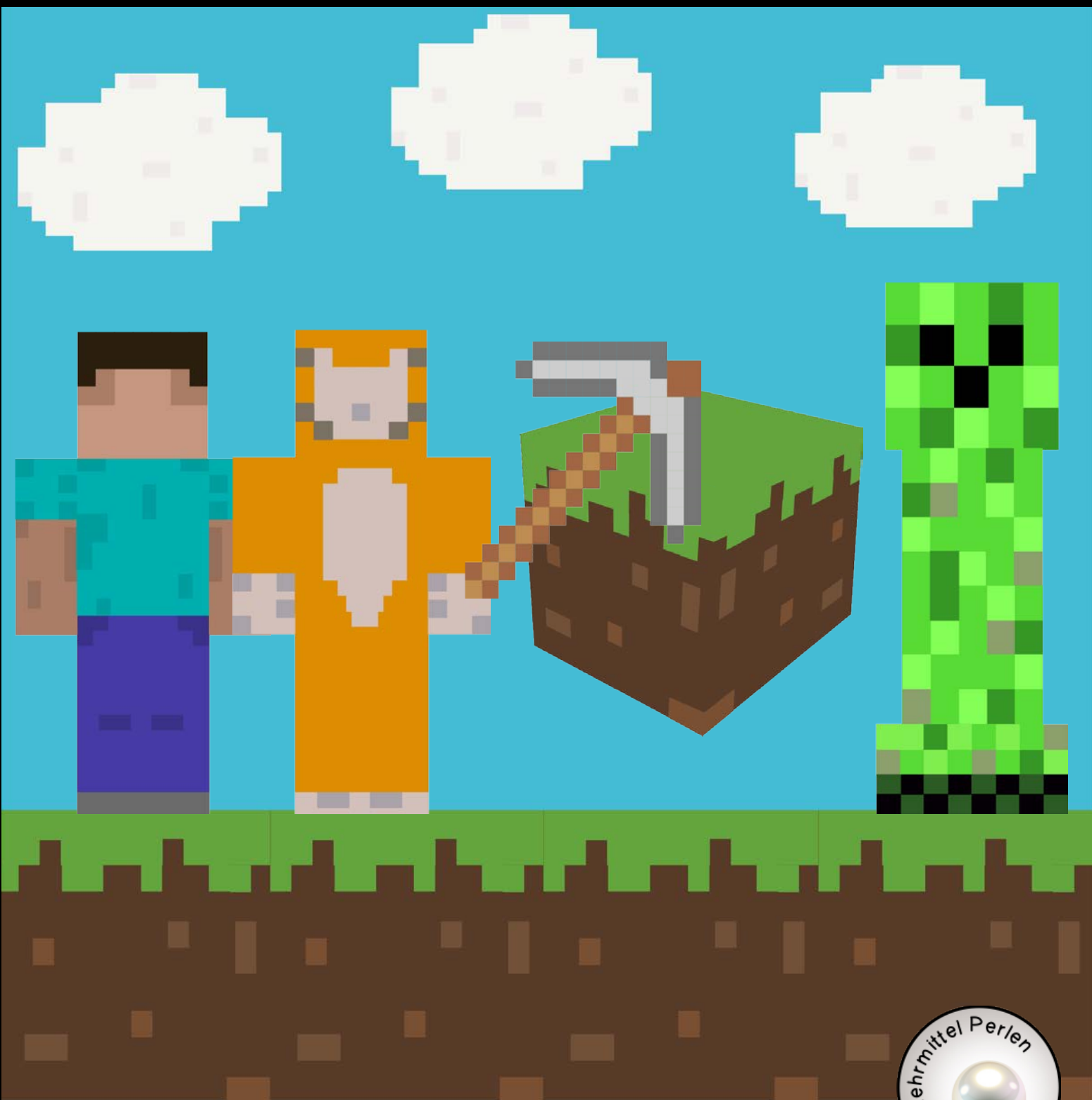

Steve also wants to take some weapons, because he saw many hostile animals around his building site. There are big spiders in the meadows and wolves live in the forest.

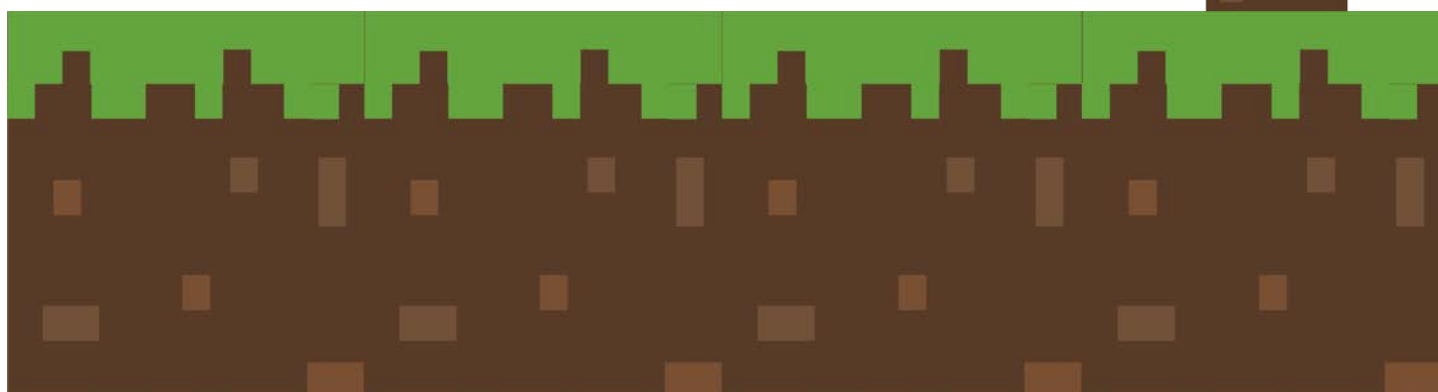

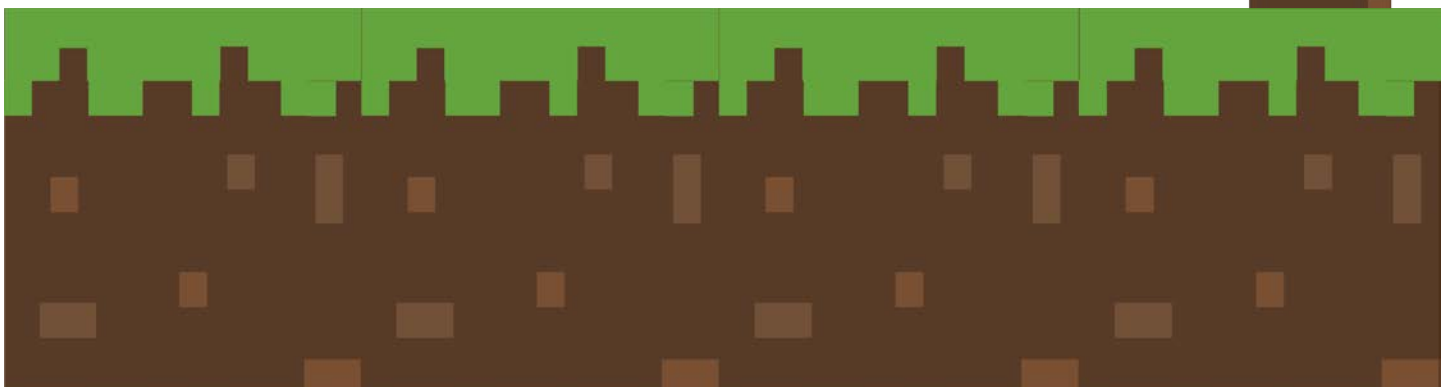

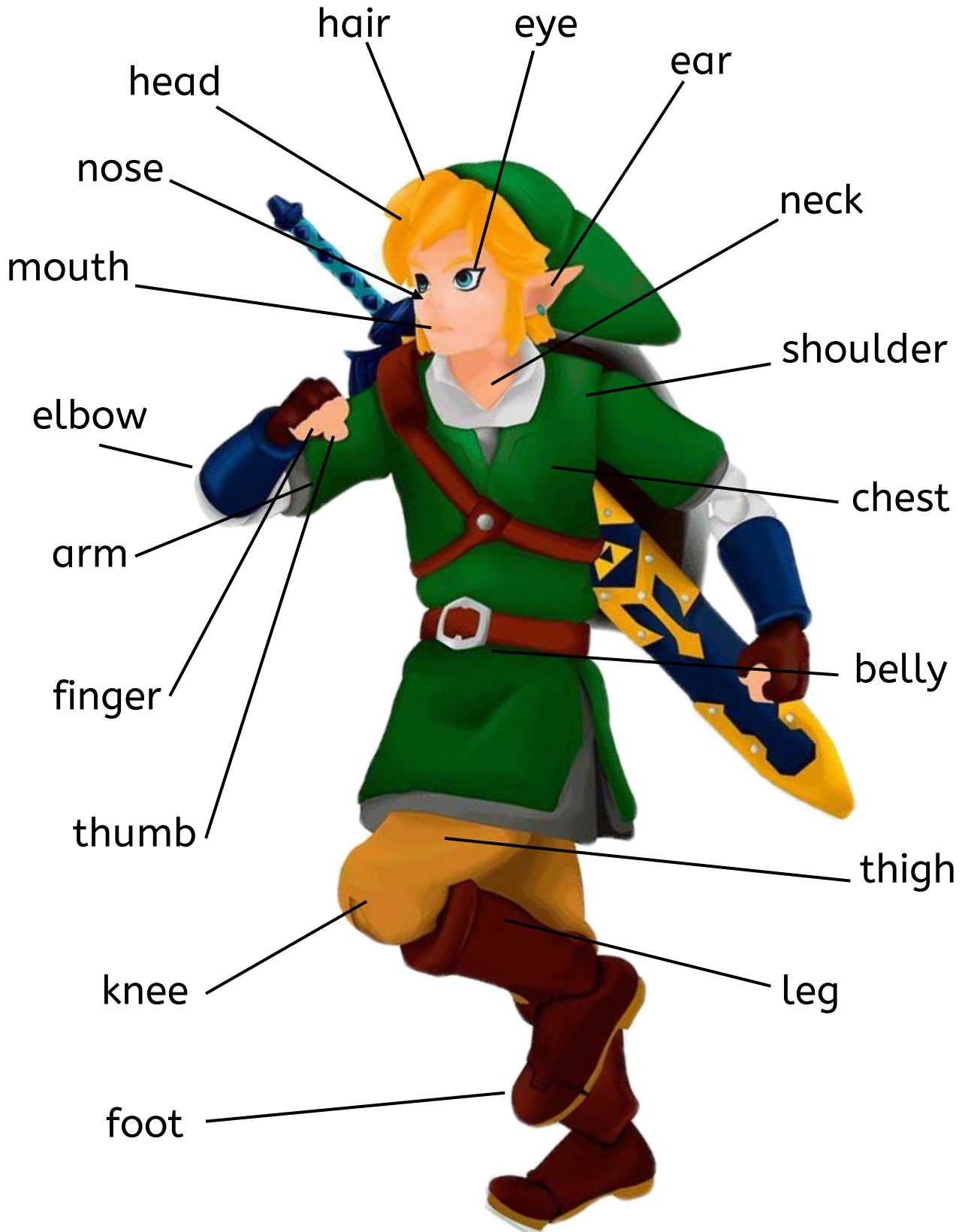
